I know that many of you appreciate catching up on news from the school via our monthly newsletter and your feedback is greatly appreciated.

Each Friday we intend emailing a one page Parent /Carer Notes to keep you informed of what is happening in school the following week. It will highlight some of the events that are happening in school and hopefully give a prompt for conversation with your children about their experiences.
