- You will recall from an earlier session that we have already had a look at The Buzz Quiz, so you should all be familiar with this webpage.
 - The Buzz Quiz is a short quiz which asks you questions about your likes and dislikes, your skills and qualities, and your preferences.
 - The quiz takes less than 5 minutes to complete and at the end you will discover which "animal" you are in terms of your strengths, what makes you tick, and your personality type.
 - You will discover jobs which are suited to your personality type which may help you when choosing your options as you will be able to find out which GCSE subjects are useful, or may be essential for certain careers.
 - You may discover jobs you haven't heard of or had not considered before. You can click on the job areas highlighted to find out more information.

If you've got a Jed licence

Visit the sign-in page and enter your establishment's access code.

If you've not got a Jed licence yet

You can use Jed in demonstration mode. Some features aren't available in demo mode, but it's a good way to see what Jed can do.

- You will need to create an account online to use this resource. You can then log on at any time to retake the test & access all the other resources available for young people.
