**Re: 'An Inspector Calls' Theatre Trip – Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023 (Evening Performance 19:30)**

As part of the GCSE English Literature course, the English Department is taking students on a visit to The Grand Opera House, York to see a performance of 'An Inspector Calls'. The visit will take place on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2023, it is an evening performance starting at 19:30 and ending at approximately 22:00. The cost of the trip will be **£18.00** per student.

This visit will allow the students the opportunity to *see* Stephen Daldry's multi award-winning National Theatre production of JB Priestley's 'An Inspector Calls' as an enrichment to their study of the play in English.

Pupils **do not** need to wear school uniform as this trip will take place out of school time in the evening. Arrangements for transport to and from the venue should be arranged by yourself, we will supervise students until they leave the venue.

Please ensure your child brings any medication they might need. Students who have prescribed Epipens and/or inhalers must have them on their person at all times, clearly labelled with their name.
