

Expectations for behaviour

- We would expect all students to behave at all times in a manner that befits members of Fulford School.
- On the <u>coach students must wear seat belts</u>. On the ferry they must follow the instructions of the ferry staff.
- Students will be asked <u>not to visit each others' bedrooms after lights out</u> and must <u>at no point visit the rooms of those of the opposite sex</u>. Windows must be fastened shut at night.
