



Examinations Summer 2023 What we do know...

- Outcomes in 2023 will be similar to those in 2019
- Formula sheets will be available for Maths and Science
- Exams can cover any topic within the specification. The assumption is that the full specification has been taught to all students nationally.



Examinations Summer 2023 What we do know...

- GCSEs planned to run between Monday 15th May and Monday 19th June
- Two contingency days 8th June and 28th June
- Timing of exams planned to ensure as large a gap as possible to allow students reduce chance of students missing exams due to illness



Examinations Summer 2023 What we do know

- There will be contingency arrangements in the event that exams do not run in Summer 2023.
- Expecting guidelines around these arrangements to be published at some point in November/December.

Mock Exams

- Two sets of mock exams
- Set 1: 21st November to 2nd December
- Set 2: 20th February to 1st March
- Each student will be given their own statement of entry for these exams.
- This will say time and venue of each of their exam and give their seat number. These will be given out in form periods. Stick it on the fridge and ask students to take a picture of it!
- A text will be sent home to inform parents when these are issued.
- When not in exams, students will follow their usual timetable



For mock set 1 we will give students an indication of the content assessed in the exams in each subject.



The Exam Rooms

- During the exam period only year 11 students are using the exam rooms
- Desks are spaced 1.25m apart
- Students must not take phones or watches into the exam rooms
- Pencil cases must be see through
- Students can take water into the exam rooms
- Students should bring their own equipment to the exams
- Students must be in full, correct uniform for all exams.



Unwell Students

- Where a student is unwell we will try to make arrangements for them to complete the exam that they have missed on their return to school.
- Where a student is absent for an extended period, we will re-schedule their exams so that they can complete them on their return to school
- In some cases it will not be possible for them to complete all the exams that they have missed. We will prioritise them being able to complete at least one exam in each subject.

Mock Examination Results

- Issued by class teachers as soon as they have been moderated.
- Use the outcomes and the targets to identify what needs to be improved.
- Sent home on reports in January.
- Mock results help to decide upon post-16 courses but look at predicted grades closely as well.





- Lates




Where do we (year 11) stand now? Reports.

Pupils with better attendance performed better

95% + = 1.1 grades better



Where do we (year 11) stand now? Attendance

At this point last year, Year 11 . . .

This term, Average attendance = 93.6%

18.3% of Y11 were below 90% (PA)

+1.1(>95%) +0.7(Ave)

Us, this year . . .

This term, Average attendance = 95.1% (up 0.5% in the last 2 weeks!)

13.1% of Y11 are below 90%
