3G Artificial Grass Pitch Consultation

Fulford School in partnership with a number of local football clubs, City of York Council and the Football Foundation, are looking to develop a new 3G Artificial Grass Pitch on the school grounds. It is a very exciting prospect and will enhance the facilities for students at school and also for the local community.
