School Uniform

Over the last few years, during summer, we have experienced occasional temperatures exceeding 30° C. During that time, we had received enquiries from parents regarding the possibility of students wearing shorts, instead of long trousers or skirts.

To support this, we are going to run a trial, during the summer term to allow students to wear shorts if they wish.

Starting after the May half term (from Monday 3rd June), all students will have the option to wear black tailored school shorts.

Whilst wearing black tailored shorts, students must also wear plain black ankle or trainer socks along with appropriate school shoes. All other aspects of the uniform must be worn correctly unless specific instructions are given, due to weather conditions.

We will assess the success of the trial before deciding if shorts are to become a permanent addition to the summer school uniform policy.

Please note that the tailored school shorts must be purchased through SchoolShop or Emblazon.

No other type of shorts will be permitted.
