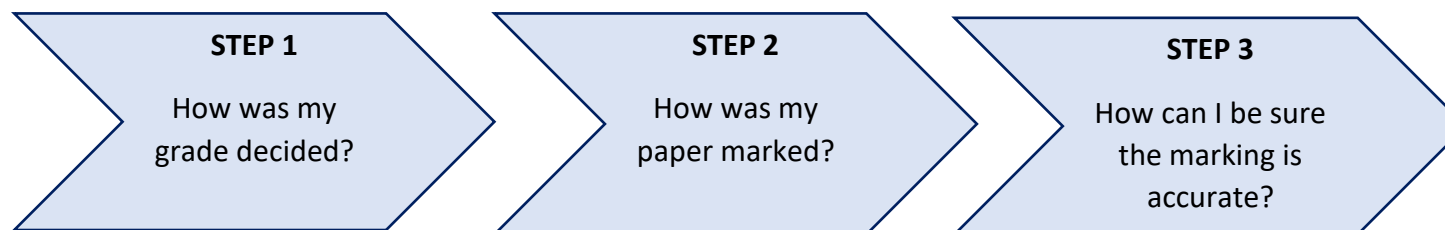




Post-results support. I have received my results and I have some questions about my marks or grades.

You can consult the exam board's website to access them.</p> <p>Alternatively, please see a member of the exams team who will be able to share the grade boundaries and a breakdown of your exam marks.</p>	<p>The exam boards offer the following free service.</p> <p><u>Access to Scripts Service</u></p> <p>Awarding bodies will provide access to your marked exam script on request.</p> <p>A digital copy of the script will be sent to the candidate's email address.</p> <div><p>Important: exam results and exam scripts belong to the candidate. The candidate must consent <u>in writing</u> to all requests for Access to Scripts, Clerical Re-checks or Reviews of Marking.</p></div>	<p>The exam boards offer the following services for a fee.</p> <p><u>Service 1 (Clerical re-check)</u></p> <p>This service will include the following checks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ that all parts of the script have been marked;✓ the totaling of marks;✓ the recording of marks <p><u>Service 2 (Review of marking)</u></p> <p>Reviewers will not re-mark the script. The script will be reviewed to check for marking errors such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• an administrative error;• a failure to apply the mark scheme where a task has only a 'right' or 'wrong' answer;• an unreasonable exercise of academic judgement.
