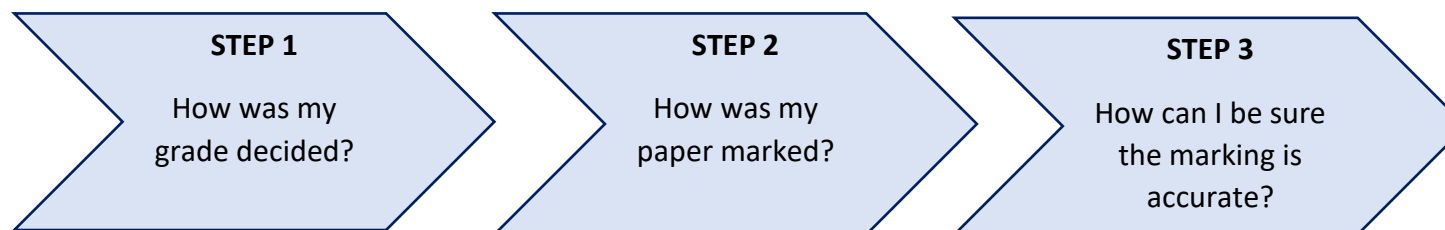




Post-results support. I have received my results and I have some questions about my marks or grades.

Grade boundary information is published by the awarding bodies on the day your results are released. You can consult the exam board's website to access them. Alternatively, please see a member of the exams team who will be able to share the grade boundaries and a breakdown of your exam marks.	The exam boards offer the following free service. <u>Access to Scripts Service</u> Awarding bodies will provide access to your marked exam script on request. A digital copy of the script will be sent to the candidate's email address. Important: exam results and exam scripts belong to the candidate. The candidate must consent <u>in writing</u> to all requests for Access to Scripts, Clerical Re-checks or Reviews of Marking.	The exam boards offer the following services for a fee. <u>Service 1 (Clerical re-check)</u> This service will include the following checks: ✓ that all parts of the script have been marked; ✓ the totaling of marks; ✓ the recording of marks <u>Service 2 (Review of marking)</u> Reviewers will not re-mark the script. The script will be reviewed to check for marking errors such as: • an administrative error; • a failure to apply the mark scheme where a task has only a 'right' or 'wrong' answer; • an unreasonable exercise of academic judgement.
